Parents can ensure that students complete all homework tasks to a high standard, which include learning vocabulary meticulously. They should encourage their son or daughter to build simple structures and to a high degree of accuracy.

Learning resources:

Each student has been given an exercise book to write in. Mira 3 textbooks, workbooks, worksheets and handouts will be supplied by the Spanish Department.
